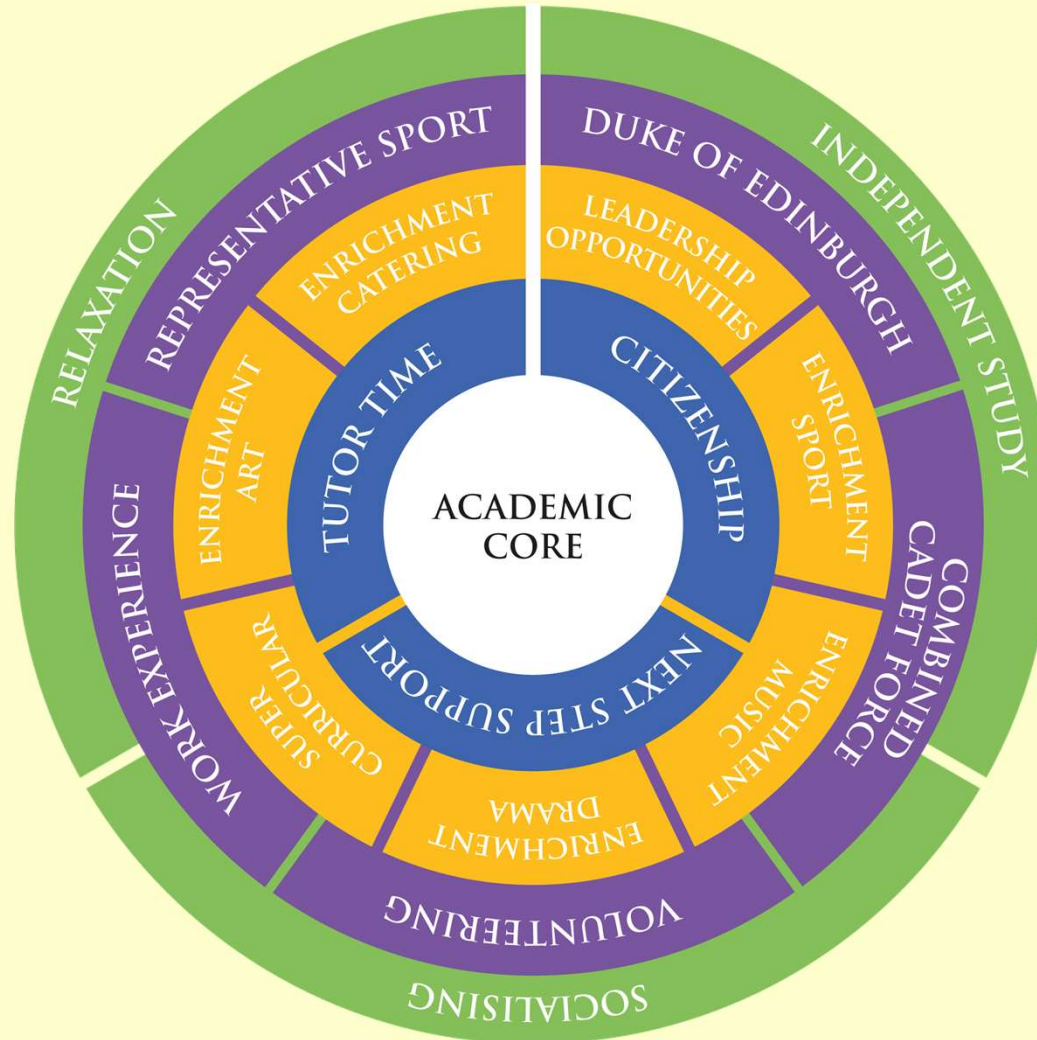

Entry Requirements



- A capped (best 8) GCSE points score of 48, with a grade 5 (or higher) in both English Language and Mathematics
- Aim for as many 6+ results as possible to maximise your choices (each course has its own entry requirements – see Subject Information guide)
- No other entry criteria (i.e. no interview to pass)

The Process

- Consider all the courses available
- Research HE/career possibilities and their requirements
- Complete the online application form (submit by 31st January)
- Attend the Experience Day on **Thursday 27th June 2024**
 - experience lessons in subjects chosen
 - further opportunities to discuss options

- Collect a copy of the Sixth Form Prospectus and relevant subject details
- Speak to subject staff and current students
- Speak to our Subject Advisors in *Le Bistro*
- Seek advice from a variety of sources
- Complete - online application form by **31st January 2024**

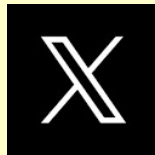
