YOUR ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

We have an unashamedly academic programme that is designed to challenge and stretch you. A minimum point score of 48 from your best 8 GCSE results and at least a grade 5 in Maths and English Language are required to join the Sixth Form (please see our Subject Information Guide for subject specific entry requirements).

On joining us you will be guided through a choice of taking 3 A levels and a 'plus option' or 4 A levels. This discussion will be centred on choosing the route that best suits your abilities and aspirations.

YOUR PLUS OPTION

These courses have been specifically chosen to add value to your post-16 choices. You will complete this qualification in Year 12, enabling you to focus on your A levels during Year 13.

Core Mathematics

The Core Mathematics course is ideal for those students who are undertaking A levels with a mathematical component such as Business Studies, Chemistry and Psychology. The course has been developed with employers, universities and professional bodies as valuable preparation for higher education and employment. It is an AS equivalent qualification.

CREST Gold Award: British Science Association

The CREST Gold award is a highly rated and nationally recognised achievement. It is an independent research project on a topic unique to you. It should contribute something new to the scientific or technological community or to a particular field of STEM.

Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

The EPQ is a totally independent piece of research on a subject of the student's choice. The qualification has been designed to develop skills that will be of benefit not only at university but also in the world of work.
