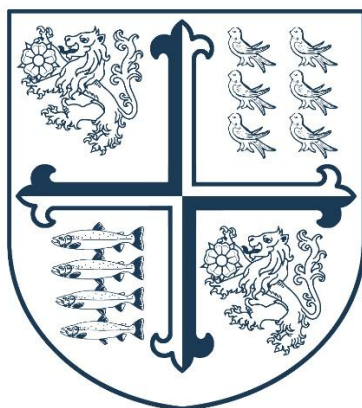

Languages Department Profile

The languages department at Bournemouth School is housed in its own building and all teachers have their own classroom. We offer French and Spanish at all key stages and German at key stage 4 and 5. There are seven language teachers in total.

Key Stage 3

All students in Years 7 and 8 study French or Spanish.

We use Studio for French, Stimmt! For German and ¡Viva! for Spanish and teachers also have access to Active Teach. All students are given access to Active Learn and homework tasks are set around Knowledge Organisers at key stages 3 and 4.

Key Stage 4

We teach GCSE over 3 years. All students must study either French or Spanish to GCSE and they may also choose German. At GCSE we follow the Edexcel specifications in French, German and Spanish. Results at GCSE are very good with the vast majority of students achieving at least a grade 5.

Key Stage 5

All languages are offered at A level although French and Spanish are significantly more popular. We follow the Edexcel specification at A level and choose to study a film and novel giving our students a wider range of experiences. We subscribe to Boost Learning for all staff and students.
