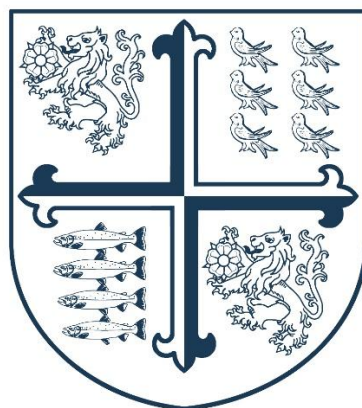

Department Vision:

"To engage and inspire students in mathematics, promoting excellent progress and attainment. We will provide students with the understanding and tools to solve problems, and apply these skills in other subjects.

We will ensure that maths is never a barrier to student' success in life, either by grades or skills"

Mathematics has always been a particular strength of Bournemouth School; students enter the school in Year 7 with a passion for mathematics, which is then nurtured throughout Key Stage 3 and 4 whereupon students are very successful at GCSE. A sign of the popularity of Mathematics is borne out with the majority of Sixth form students taking A-level, with 40 students taking Further Mathematics this year. With the popularity rising, we are now looking to expand our team, and are looking to appoint a well-qualified teacher of Mathematics who is able to teach up to and including A-level.



Our purpose-built accommodation comprises of 9 spacious classrooms, all containing projectors, and multiple whiteboards. The department's own office is very spacious with staff having a quiet area to work outside of their classroom.

We are a well-resourced department, with purposefully made lesson resources to fit our Scheme of Learning. Throughout all years we use Pearson Edexcel, with GCSE and A-level exams being sat with this exam board. For KS3 and KS4, we subscribe to Dr Frost Maths to facilitate the setting of homework which is automatically marked.

For A-level we subscribe to Activelearn, which provides digital resources for staff and students. Students have regular assessments at the end of each chapter, which form the backbone of our marking and feedback policy.

In Years 7 and 8 the pupils are taught Mathematics in mixed ability groups, but they are set in Years 9 to 11. Due to rising popularity, this year there are five A-level Mathematics classes in each of Year 12 and Year 13, with an additional two Further Mathematics class in each of Year 12 and Year 13. Core Maths is taught to an additional three classes in Year 12, who sit their exam at the end of the year.



Pupils in Years 7 and 8 consolidate and extend their mathematical knowledge, ensuring they are at an appropriate level to begin the GCSE course in Year 9. In Years 9 to 11, the pupils use the Pearson Edexcel textbooks and department made resources to cover and consolidate knowledge, with regular check in tests.



The 2024 examination results reflect the strength of the subject within the school. At GCSE 73% of pupils achieved grade 7 and above and 22% grade 9, whilst at A Level 68% of candidates achieved grades A* to B.

This post will allow the successful candidate to join an experienced team with a fine reputation. It is equally suitable for an experienced teacher looking for a new challenge or for a new entrant to the profession, who is looking to extend their teaching repertoire across all Key Stages at a high level.
